Vision School is..

Vision School is InterCP's core mission training program. Vision School will challenge your worldview as a Christian, empower you to live a gospel driven lifestyle, and enable you to take the first step into serving the unreached nations.

〈Christchurch VS Training Topics〉

Week 1 “Not My Vision but His Vision” “Global Mission Status” (22/04)	A biblical overview of God’s redemptive history and His plan from the beginning and a survey of the consistency of His vision and purpose demonstrated in the three persons of God. This lecture introduces God’s vision and heart for all nations to return to Him (Revelations 7:9-10)
Week 2 “World Missions History” (29/04)	A biblical and historical overview of the gospel movement throughout history. This lecture will look at history from the perspective of “God’s pursuit after all nations” and how people of God have been making history with him. It’ll also examine where we’re at now and how we can all participate in completing God’s history
Week 3 “Understanding Islam” (06/05)	Explains the history and doctrine of Islam—the religion that most of the unreached nations believe in. Through explanation of the culture and identity of Muslims, this lecture aims to shift students’ paradigms from how the world views Muslims and impart God’s love for the Muslims onto the students. This lecture will also help students understand the mission strategy for the Islamic nations
Week 4 “Times” (Video Lecture) (13/05)	Exposes today’s post-modern culture and society and the progression of capitalism in the world, as well as identifying the key ideologies that influence our lives. This lecture will awaken the students to the urgent times that we live in, and share mission strategies and values for mission movement in the modern times
Week 5 “Spiritual Warfare & Intercessory Prayer” (20/05)	Challenges students to commit as intercessors, who will be responsible for the nations through committed intercession. Through explanation of the microscopic and macroscopic spiritual warfare, students will be awakened to the spiritual reality of our world and how relevant spiritual warfare and intercessory prayer is to mission-work. It will help them to understand the authority that God has given us to cast down the powers of the darkness that bind and oppress the nations, and realize the power of intercession.
Week 6 “Window lecture” (27/05)	Each Window lecture explains the concept of “windows” and surveys one of the different windows in the 10/40 region (Central Asia, China Frontiers, Arab, Indo-China, Persia, Volga-Ural, Caucasus, North India, Maghreb, Asia Minor, Mongol-Siberia, etc). Speakers will share the most recent stories of how God’s kingdom is at work among the nations

	<p>and explain the importance of understanding the cultural and social background of a nation when doing mission-work. This lecture will also educate students about what a missionary's lifestyle must look like in order to effectively preach the Gospel and challenges students to live a missional lifestyle. Through this lecture, students will understand God's heart and love for these people groups in order to commit to adopt one nation.</p>
<p>Week 7 "MIT" (City ministry) (03/06)</p>	<p>Students will experience the power of the gospel through practical evangelism. We will spiritually map out the history and stronghold of the city and go out together to share the gospel together as a team.</p>
<p>Week 8 Mission Spirit & Graduation (10/06)</p>	<p>Explains the spirit of frontier missions, holistic missions, Lordship, power missions, and etc. It also helps students to realize God's commandment for missions, and that the call for missions is for all people – that the calling is not for a specific group of people who receives it in a special way, but for all Christians who have received salvation through Christ Jesus. This lecture also helps students understand that there is an open invitation for all Christians to partake in the Kingdom work regardless of one's testimony, status, education, or wealth, and encourages them to commit to God's Kingdom.</p>
